Meeting was called to order at 9:05 a.m. by Judge Wayne Nance.

Open Forum: Judge Nance informed the court that TxDOT would be replacing the bridge on Mulberry Creek and showed the commissioners several options for detouring traffic during construction. Texas Lighting LLC had submitted a bid for replacing lighting fixtures. This will be on the agenda at a later time. Judge Nance also informed the court that a representative from TAC will be at the October 11th meeting to discuss a personnel policy.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of this document is to define the restoration and preservation, digital capture, storage, retention and management of all records belonging to the Briscoe County and District Clerk's office. It is the intent of the Briscoe County and District Clerk to follow the guidelines set by the Texas State Library and Archives Commission.

GOAL

The goal is to archive all recordable documents that come into the possession of the Briscoe County and District Clerk regardless of type, as efficiently as possible and to image all real estate records and court case documents to aid in search capabilities of such records.

SCOPE

The scope of this document includes the following:

- *All County Clerk records filed at the Briscoe County Courthouse
- *All District Clerk records filed at the Briscoe County Courthouse
- *Plans to restore and preserve records with significant historical value
- *Future plans are to improve public and governmental access and provide an archive for records that have or will be imaged.

This document addresses the restoration and preservation needs of the Briscoe County and District Clerk Records Archive. No other departments are addressed.

SECTION ONE: RECORDS CURRENTLY IN REPOSITORY - INVENTORY

Currently the Briscoe County and District Clerk's Office holds over 250 volumes regarding real estate records, liens, military discharges, marriage licenses, birth and death records and 5000+ files that are related to civil and criminal actions which have occurred throughout the years.

<u>SECTION TWO: RESTORATION AND PRESERVATION</u> - <u>PERMANENT RECORDS</u>

We have discontinued recording the OPR records and court documents in books and only record and store them by electronic means, a public terminal is located in the clerk's office for searching real estate records and court documents. An off-site back up captures the images daily. Several volumes of Deed Records are imaged so this last year 12 of these were digitally indexed and imported to our documents that are located in ONYX (our recording program) and may be searched and assessed through the public terminal.

SECTION THREE: FUTURE PLANS

I would like to start imaging the older "Probate Records". Don't have a specific plan for this but upcoming in the future.
