Motion was made by Commissioner Burson to approve the agreement for the county audit with Bolinger, Segars, Gilbert, and Moss LLP for the amount of \$11,500. Seconded by Commissioner Wellman, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Commissioner Burson to approve the agreement for the audit of the office of Justice of the Peace, Precinct 2, with Bolinger, Segars, Gilbert, and Moss LLP for the amount of, not to exceed \$1,000. Seconded by Commissioner Wood, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wellman to accept the resignation of Jared Johnson as Justice of the Peace, Precinct 2, effective June 30, 2024. Seconded by Commissioner Wood, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Discussion was had on taking applications for Justice of the Peace, Precinct 2, to be due to the Briscoe County Judge by noon on July 3<sup>rd</sup>. Also discussed was scheduling interviews for 1:00 P.M. on July 8<sup>th</sup> for the appointment of a Justice of the Peace, Precinct 2-No Action
